the United Church of Christ in North Hampton. The following information is to help you make your way through the worship service this morning.

Nametags

Stick-on nametags can be found in the entryway of the church on the table under the stained glass window. Congregants and guests are encouraged to wear nametags to help us meet and remember each other names.

Personal Needs

- Assisted listening devices can be found in the back of the sanctuary.
- There are large print bulletins, which can be found in the back of the sanctuary and on the table in the prayer room.
- The <u>restrooms</u> are on the first floor of the church. To find them, go down the stairs at the back of the sanctuary, through the fellowship hall (O'Connor Vestry) and continue into the hallway past the kitchen. The restrooms are on the right. The middle restroom is accessible. See diagram on back.
- There is an accessibility lift located outside the prayer room (through the door by the organ). Once you go through the prayer room, the lift is on the right. Downstairs it is located next to the east entrance.

Worship Stuff for Wigglers

Feel free to take Worship materials for each of your children and/or for yourself to use during worship. They can be found on one of the tables at the back of the sanctuary.

The Family Room

If you are in need of a quiet space to rock your infant or a place where your toddler can roam, there is a family room at the back of the sanctuary. It is equipped with sound so that you can close the door and tend to your family's needs and still participate in worship. There you will find toys for toddlers and a changing table for infants.

Faith Finders

During worship the children of the church often leave with Ms. Pam and a volunteer, after the Children's Message, for their Faith Finders Program. This is a time for youth ages 3 years old through eighth grade. The children can be picked up after worship in the Garden Room which is on the ground floor next to the church office.

Joys & Concerns

Each week in worship, we pray, reflect, receive and give. During the prayer time, we gratefully and respectfully lift prayers of joy and concern to God as a community. You are invited to share your personal prayers of joy and care. If you would like to share on behalf of someone else, as a courtesy to those who are more private in their prayers, please do ask permission before sharing.

Coffee Hour

Following worship, all are invited for coffee and conversation downstairs in the fellowship area (O'Connor Vestry). If you have any questions, you can see Rev. Mike.

Recycling Bulletins

There are baskets at the exits of the sanctuary for you to recycle your bulletin if you choose not to take it home with you. Thank you for helping the church be green through your paper recycling.


